- * Treats and Toys are allowed in the ring.

FUN RUN FEE \$30 PER DOG – Experience required. Standard and Jumpers Rings. Numbered courses for Advanced and Novice Levels. You may also make your own course or do the shorter drills we have designed. Each Dog has 75 seconds per run. 2 Standard and 2 Jumpers runs. 4 runs total. WORKSHOP FEE \$50 PER DOG – Experience required. Dogs should be familiar with all equipment.
