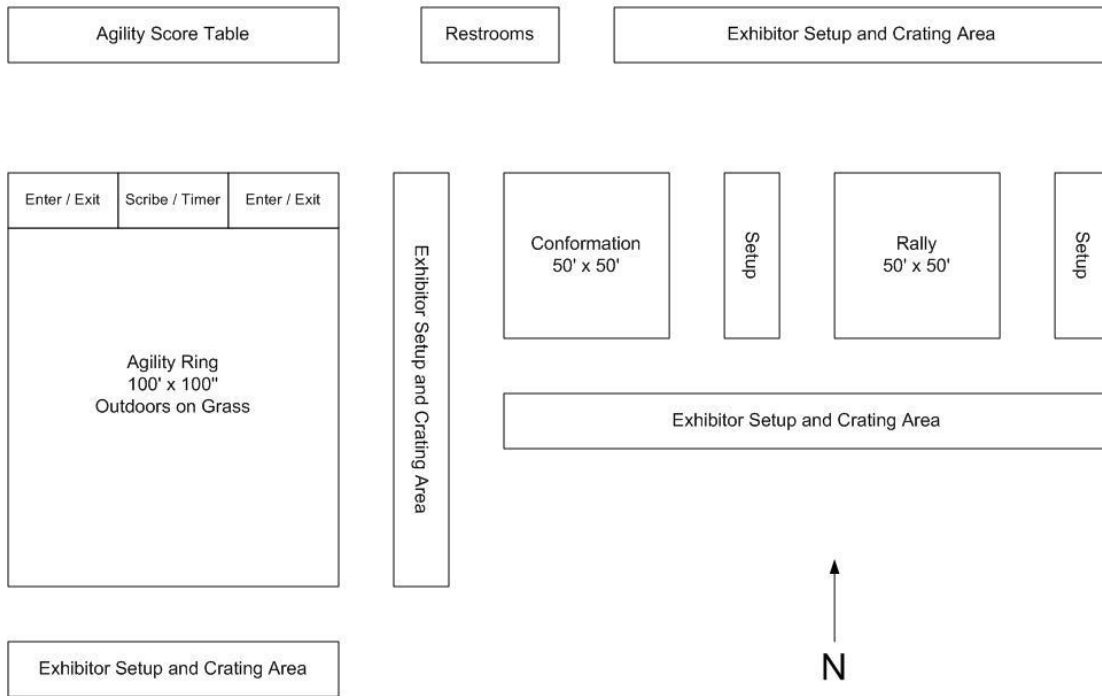

- Parking** No overnight parking. Park your vehicle in the Doyle Elementary School parking lot. Turn right when you first enter the school grounds. Please be respectful of the residents living near the elementary school. Keep your dogs from barking excessively upon arrival. Do not leave dogs in your car unattended.
- Early Setup** Friday at 4PM. Please stake down your canopy. Do not leave your valuables overnight. Sprinklers may come on accidentally overnight. As a precaution, do not leave anything that needs to stay dry.

- Etiquette** We encourage all exhibitors to follow our trial guidelines:

- Barking** Our field is adjacent to a residential neighborhood. Excessive barking needs to be controlled. It is okay for dogs to bark while running on course, but if your dog is barking too much in the parking lot, setup area, at the practice jump or before they go into the ring then it becomes a problem. Please keep barking to a minimum.
- Leashes** Dogs must be on-leash at all times except in the ring or at the warm up obstacles. Doyle Elementary School is a large field, but it is not an off-leash free zone.



- Clean Up** The Doyle Elementary School requires special attention to making sure that we clean up after our dogs. If you run out of bags, we have extras. If you see anything that has not been picked up then “adopt a poop” or please tell us. We will facilitate a tidy operation.
- Restrooms** Portable restrooms are available on site.
- The Beach** If you think your dog has enough energy to hit the surf, there are many dog friendly beaches to hang five – Del Mar, Ocean Beach, Coronado. Water temps can be cool.
- Feedback** We are interested both your genuine compliments and in how you think we can improve. We normally have a suggestion box at the show. Please feel free to offer us your ideas to make a better experience for you and your dog.
- Come Again** We hope you enjoy yourself and achieve your personal competition and training goals. Have a safe drive and enjoy your stay in La Jolla and San Diego, America’s Finest City.
