- Welcome** Hello and welcome to our St. Patrick's Day ASCA Agility Trial on March 16-17, 2013
- Hosted By** The Australian Shepherd Club of San Diego County and Performance Dog Training.
- Location** Doyle Elementary School, 3950 Berino Ct, La Jolla, CA 92122
- Directions** I-5 South - Exit La Jolla Village, Left on La Jolla Village, Right on Regents, Left on Berino.
I-5 North - Exit Nobel, Right on Nobel, Right on Regents, Left on Berino.
- Friday Setup** 4:00PM – 6:00PM. Please stake down your canopy. Do not leave your valuables overnight. Sprinklers may come on accidentally overnight. As a precaution, do not leave anything that needs to stay dry.
- Trial Hours** Saturday and Sunday
- 6:30 Field Opens
 - 7:00 Check-in and Measuring
 - 8:00 General Briefing
 - 8:30 First dog on the line
- Weather** The weather forecast predicts a dry and partly cloudy weekend with temperatures in the mid 70 degree range. [WEEKEND WEATHER](#)
- Parking** Park your vehicle in the Doyle Elementary School parking lot. Turn right when you first enter the school grounds. Please be respectful of the residents living near the elementary school. Keep your dogs from barking excessively upon arrival. Do not leave dogs in your car unattended. Overflow parking is at Doyle Park and Recreation Center.
- Barking** Our field is adjacent to a residential neighborhood. Excessive barking needs to be controlled! It is okay for dogs to bark while running on course, but if your dog is barking too much in the setup area, please help keep them quiet.
- Restrooms** Portable restrooms are available on site.
- Day of Show** We are accepting day-of-show and FEO entries both days, all day. The cost for a day-of-show entry is \$15 per run.
- Run Order** **Saturday** – Tall to Small - Jumpers 1 & 2 (Elite, Open, Novice) - Regular 1 & 2 (Elite, Open, Novice) - Gamblers 1 (Elite, Open, Novice)
Sunday – Small to Tall - Gamblers 2 (Elite, Open, Novice) - Regular 3 & 4 (Elite, Open, Novice) - Jumpers 3 & 4 (Elite, Open, Novice)
