- Directions** **From I-5 North or South** - Exit La Paz Rd. Head east for approximately 2 miles, turn left on Veterans Way, continue on Veterans Way until the road ends at the Norman P. Murray Community Center. Continue on a soft right curve into the parking lot. The Village Green Field will be on your left.

Facility

This is the first time an agility trial will be held at the Norman P. Murray Center. We want to leave a good impression and increase our chances of using it again. We ask all exhibitors to be vigilant in picking up after their dogs. This is also a public park, which is friendly to all dogs. Spectators are welcome. Please inform the trial committee if there is a potential problem with people, dogs, or especially children near the ring. We will handle it diplomatically.

Leashes

Dogs must be on-leash at all times except in the ring or at the practice jump..

Beginners

We will have a beginners agility ring with easy-to-do obstacles for people and dogs who are new to agility. The cost is \$5. If you see a spectator that wants to learn more about agility then direct them toward the beginner agility ring. This is not open to dogs entered in the trial. [Agility Competition Flier](#)

Clean Up

Please clean up after your dogs. If you run out of bags, we have extras. If you see anything that has not been picked up then “adopt a poop” or please tell us. We will facilitate a tidy operation.
