**ENTRY RULES**

**Exhibitors, through submission of entry you acknowledge that you have read NADAC Rules & Regulations as presented on [www.nadac.com](http://www.nadac.com) including but not limited to:**

- This test is open to all dogs of at least 18 months of age, including mixed breeds.
- Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog’s ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog. Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
- Safety must always be of primary consideration in your actions and conduct. You alone are responsible for the behavior of your dogs and children. If your dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, the show committee can ask you to leave the show site. In such case, we will not refund any fees.
- All dogs, Novice, Open and Elite jumping 16” or less (except Veterans/Skilled Division dogs) **MUST** be measured unless they present a permanent height card at check-in or have sent a copy to the trial secretary along with their entry
- No leads, collars, toys, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring at any time – enclosed and concealed food can be taken on course.
- Running order will be determined at the clubs discretion. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will be separated.
- Check-in and Start Times – we will e-mail confirmations prior to the trial; these will include check-in and start times and running order information. (subject to changes)
- Refunds –After the closing date, NO entry fees will be refunded for dogs pulled from the trial - except for bitches that come into season before Thursday of the trial week in which case 50% of the entry fees paid will be returned.
- Move-ups – we will accept pre-trial move-ups until the first dog on the line on the first day of the event. If you title during the weekend we will accept your move-up request at the end of the day for the following day.

**IMPORTANT:** Please check your dog’s NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the [www.NADACForum.com](http://www.NADACForum.com) within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. Note: The **\*Proficient** line above indicates your dog’s Standard Jump Height. Your dog’s actual jump height is based upon the Standard Jump Height, the Division (Standard, Jr. Handler, Veteran, Vet Handler), and the Category (Skilled, Proficient) which you enter.

### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS**

**Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.**

1. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
2. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
3. Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.
4. Through submission of their entry, the exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules in the current Exhibitor Handbook.
5. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee shall be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

### **AGREEMENT**

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC, Performance Dog Training (including their officers, directors, employees, members, and event organizing committees), and the City of San Diego, including its officers, agents and employees, and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the forementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

**Please Note: For Non-Jumping Classes (Touch N Go, Weavers, Hoopers and Tunnelers), there is only Standard and Veteran Handler Division - no Veteran Dog or Junior Handler. For the Extreme Games Classes (EGC) you will be entered into the Standard Division Jump Height your dog measures into - no Breed Exemption, Veteran Handler, Veteran Dog or Junior Handler.**

**As of January-2014:** Dogs must enter the Veterans Division in all jumping classes after their 9th birthday. After their 12th birthday, dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes.
