Combo - if part of the combo is faulted you must complete the other obstacle
In the opening the combo can be taken in either direction

CLOSING: 2 THROUGH 7 IN THE CORRECT ORDER.

FULLHOUSE

All obstacles may be taken twice for points and back to back obstacles are allowed if done safely.

Once you complete your point accumulation, you may go to the table at any time. Once the horn blows, you have 5 seconds for your dog to touch the table to stop the clock, or lose one point per full second over time

Large Dogs: 30 seconds;
Small Dogs: 35 seconds;
16" vets jumping 12" get big Dog time.

Level 1 19 points
Level 2 21 points
Level 3 23 points
Level 5/C-25 points
Specialists and Enthusiasts: Two points fewer
