Follow the frontage road around the baseball fields until you arrive at Hourglass Park (see map on page 4).

**Leashes**

Dogs must be on-leash at all times except in the ring or at the warm up obstacles.

**Barking**

Excessive barking needs to be controlled. It is okay for dogs to bark while running on course, but if your dog is barking too much in the parking lot, setup area, at the practice jump or before they go into the ring then it becomes a problem. Please keep barking to a minimum.

**Clean Up**

Hourglass Park requires special attention to making sure that we clean up after our dogs. If you run out of bags, we have extras. If you see anything that has not been picked up then “adopt a poop” or please tell us. We will facilitate a tidy operation.

**The Beach**

If you think your dog has enough energy to hit the surf, there are many dog friendly beaches to hang five – Del Mar, Ocean Beach, Coronado. Water temps can be cool.
