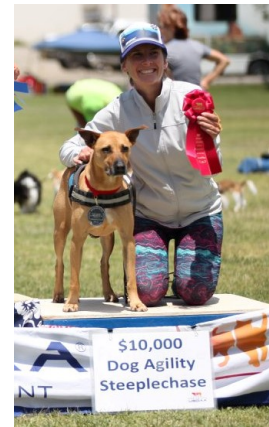
Jean Donaldson said of Dan:

She has been training behavior modification and sport dogs professionally since 2010. She currently competes with two of her dogs in AKC, USDAA, and UKI agility, as well as works as a behavior consultant out of her facility Dogs Abound in San Marcos. Liz has been a Certified Professional Dog Trainer (CPDT-KA) since 2011, and is a professional member of APDT.

In 2018, she and her dogs competed at the AKC National Championship, USDAA's Cynosport World Games, and the UKI US Open. Both dogs also competed in the Semifinals rounds at Cynosport.

INTRODUCING CANINE CONDITIONING



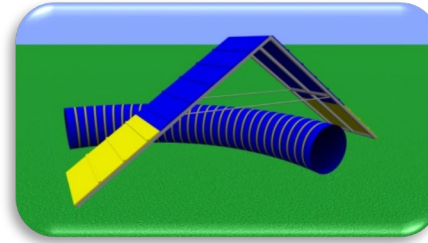
