- Fri Setup** Arrive no earlier than 6PM on Friday to set up. Stake down your canopy and do not leave valuables overnight.
- Sat / Sun** The field opens each morning at 6:30am.
- Camping** Dry RV and Tent camping is allowed on the field. Spots are limited. RVs may park overnight on the field with overflow across the street. The cost is \$10 per night payable to Lakeside ASC. You must contact me in advance. **BLOCKS ARE REQUIRED UNDER YOUR LEVELERS.**
