Barking

Our field is adjacent to a residential neighborhood. Excessive barking needs to be controlled. It is okay for dogs to bark while running on course, but if your dog is barking too much in the parking lot, setup area, at the practice jump or before they go into the ring then it becomes a problem. Please keep barking to a minimum.

Leashes

Dogs must be on-leash at all times except in the ring or at the warm up obstacle. Doyle Elementary School is a large field, but it is not an off-leash free zone.

Clean Up

The Doyle Elementary School requires special attention to cleaning up after our dogs. If you run out of bags, we have extras. If you see anything that has not been picked up then “adopt a poop” or please tell us. We will facilitate a tidy operation.

Dog Beach

There are off-leash beaches at Ocean Beach, Del Mar and Coronado. Ask us for directions.
