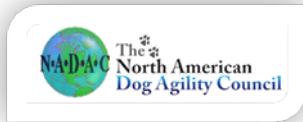

Agility Confirmations: Information regarding classes you have entered will be emailed to all entrants who have provided a valid email address. PLEASE READ YOUR CONFIRMATIONS! Contact the trial secretary ASAP with any corrections and or move-ups. A general information letter will be emailed to all exhibitors during the week of the trial confirming directions, times for setup, check-in, measuring, first dog on the line, class run order, volunteers, etc.

Class Changes: Move-ups must be submitted in writing (email ok) to the Trial Secretary, dan@performancedogtraining.com, before the trial. Move-ups will be allowed from one day to the next, during the trial. Please submit move-up information ASAP.

Double Run: When 2 rounds of a class are offered on the same day then both rounds are the same course and are run back to back without a second walk-through.

Containerized Trial: This is a containerized trial. Exhibitors may enter the ring with a closed/sealed container of treats or toy in their pocket. (see rule book for more details)

Awards: Offering 1st through 4th place ribbons in each class for each jump height division. Qualifying Ribbons offered to every dog obtaining a qualifying score.

Directions to the show site:

From I-5 North – Take the Nobel Drive exit and turn right on Nobel Drive, turn right on Regents Road, turn left on Berino Ct. See Doyle Elementary School straight ahead.

From I-5 South – Take the La Jolla Village Drive exit, turn left on La Jolla Village Drive, turn right on Regents Road, turn left on Berino Ct. See Doyle Elementary School straight ahead.

ENTRY RULES

Exhibitors, through submission of entry you acknowledge that you have read NADAC Rules & Regulations as presented on www.nadac.com including but not limited to:

- This test is open to all dogs of at least 18 months of age, including mixed breeds.
- Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog. Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
- Safety must always be of primary consideration in your actions and conduct. You alone are responsible for the behavior of your dogs and children. If your dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, the show committee can ask you to leave the show site. In such case, we will not refund any fees.
- All dogs, Novice, Open and Elite jumping 16" or less (except Veterans/Skilled Division dogs) **MUST** be measured unless they present a permanent height card at check-in or have sent a copy to the trial secretary along with their entry
- No leads, collars, toys, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring at any time – enclosed and concealed food can be taken on course.
- Running order will be determined at the clubs discretion. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will be separated.
- Check-in and Start Times – we will e-mail confirmations prior to the trial; these will include check-in and start times and running order information. (subject to changes)
- Refunds – NO entry fees will be refunded for dogs pulled from the trial - except for bitches in season or for dogs that are injured. In most cases 50% of the entry fees will be returned in vouchers.
- Move-ups – we will accept pre-trial move-ups until the first dog on the line on the first day of the event. If you title during the weekend we will accept your move-up request at the end of the day for the following day.

IMPORTANT: Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

1. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
2. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
3. Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted.
4. Through submission of their entry, the exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules in the current Exhibitor Handbook.
5. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee shall be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC, Performance Dog Training (including their officers, directors, employees, members, and event organizing committees), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the forementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

As of January-2014: Dogs must enter the Veterans Division in all jumping classes after their 9th birthday. After their 12th birthday, dogs must enter the Skilled Category, Veterans Division for jumping classes and Skilled Category for non-jumping classes.
